On another note, I am saddened to find another example of where firearm dealers do not comply with the Consumer Protection Act. His Terms and Conditions provide in a number of instances that no refunds on the purchase price of a firearm will be given and that if the sale is cancelled he will sell the firearm and the purchaser will bear any losses. He also sells the firearm “voetstoots”, which is contrary to the provisions of the Consumer Protection Act. If he does not answer my request that to change his Terms and Conditions then I may disclose who it is. Quite interestingly, he is not a member of the South African Arms and Ammunition Dealers Association. I have drafted the contract on behalf of the South African Arms and Ammunition Dealers Association, which expressly provides that the Consumer Protection Act applies.
